Post-Operative Work Restriction Guidelines for Surgical Fixation of Distal Radius Fracture*

| EXPECTED POST OPERATIVE RECOVERY TIMELINE | POST OPERATIVE WORK RESTRICTIONS |
|--|---|
| Day of Surgery through 2 weeks post-op | Off Work |
| Post-op week 2 through week 8 | Return to work with no use of affected extremity |
| Post-op week 8 through week 10 | Increase use of affected extremity (depending on x-ray) |
| Post-op week 10 through week 12 | Return to regular duties, MMI |

Restrictions may vary in the event of post-operative complications or unanticipated changes in your condition.

- Your employer will determine if you are able to return to work with the restrictions given by your physician.
- Restrictions are to be followed at work and at home.
- You may drive three days after your surgery if you are not taking narcotic medication and feel safe to drive. If you continue to feel unsafe to drive, it is your responsibility to arrange transportation to work.
