## Post-Operative Work Restriction Guidelines for Trigger Finger Release\*

<b>EXPECTED POST OPERATIVE RECOVERY TIMELINE</b>	<b>POST OPERATIVE WORK RESTRICTIONS*</b>
Day of Surgery and Post-op day 1	Off Work
Post-op day 2 through 10-14 days	Return to work with no use of affected extremity
Post-op day 10-14 through week 4-6	Increase use of affected extremity
Post-op week 4-6	Return to regular duties
Post-op follow up appointment week 8-10	MMI, NO PPI

**Restrictions may vary in the event of post-operative complications or unanticipated changes in your condition.**

- Your employer will determine if you are able to return to work with the restrictions given by your physician.
- Restrictions are to be followed at work and at home.
- You may drive three days after your surgery if you are not taking narcotic medication and feel safe to drive. If you continue to feel unsafe to drive, it is your responsibility to arrange transportation to work.
